The 2002 Nicotine Anonymous Conference will be held at the New York Marriott Hotel, 333 Adams Street, Brooklyn, New York. The dates of the conference are Friday, April 19, Saturday, April 20 and Sunday, April 21, 2002.

The world famous Brooklyn Bridge is a short walk away. The Marriott Hotel itself is very beautiful and is just 3 years old. It has an indoor lap pool, and spa and expansive health club facilities, all free to guests.

Around the corner of the hotel is a wonderful area full of shops and restaurants. There are at least 6 nearby subway lines and New York City is just a subway ride away.

The 2002 Conference will follow the standard format that has worked so well over the years. Friday evening, April 19, will be the always powerful and inspirational Gratitude Meeting. The business of the conference will be conducted at various sessions during the day on Saturday. This will include reports by various officers, committee chairpersons and other trusted servants. Nominations for officers and possible sites for the 2004 conference will be introduced. Workshops on a variety of topics will be held.

The workshop topics are expected to mainly focus on issues to be considered by the delegates as they guide our fellowship in group conscience. In addition, our conference will be holding Marathon Meetings on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

There will, of course, be the Saturday evening banquet and speaker meeting and the Sunday morning Spirituality Breakfast Buffet. Sunday morning delegates will express the fellowship's group conscience in voting on the various candidates and issues before the conference.

A special post-conference event that is being planned for Sunday afternoon features a tour of the Statue of Liberty. The cost of this optional event is \$7 for adults and \$6 for senior citizens. Please make your travel arrangements around this super activity so that you will be able to join the group that intends to visit the standard of our 2002 conference!

We hope that you might come to New York a few days early to experience the uniqueness of our area of the U.S.
